

Frequently Asked Questions  
Revised Louisiana PCSP Grant Application

---

**1. I have already received a grant for start-up and/or implementation and I have remaining eligibility. What should I submit to the Department?**

*Schools that have received PCSP grant funds in the past should submit a budget covering the full 3 years of eligibility up to the maximum amount specified in the grant application by November 7.*

*In preparing your new budgets, please reflect previous awards without revision. For example, if your maximum award in the application is \$600,000 and received a \$200,000 start-up grant in 2006 and a \$200,000 implementation grant last year, you should submit a 3-year budget reflecting the \$200,000 start-up in year one, the \$200,000 implementation in year two, and budgeting \$200,000 for year three.*

**2. I have already received a grant for start-up and/or implementation, and I have remaining eligibility. However, I do not have a pending application or an approved award for 2008-09. What should I submit to the Department?**

*In addition to submitting the revised budget, you should submit a Continuation Request by November 21<sup>st</sup>. Please see the application for the format of a Continuation Request.*

**3. I have already submitted an application for my last phase of implementation. What should I submit to the Department?**

*Schools already approved for the last phase of Implementation are not required to submit a new budget. However, those schools must submit a Final Report to the Department in accordance with the application instructions.*

**4. I submitted my application for a Type 2 or Type 5 charter school on October 10, 2008, and I am awaiting BESE approval in December. What should I submit to the Department?**

*You should prepare the application for PSCP funds and submit it to the Department by November 7. A recommendation to approve your charter school application and PSCP grant award will be presented to BESE at its December meeting.*

**5. My charter school application has been approved and the school is currently in operation. However, I have never submitted for the PCSP grant. What should I do?**

*You must submit a grant application by November 7. This requires completing the new grant application and a budget for the maximum amount you are eligible to receive.*
