

Graduation Exit Exams (GEE) to End of Course (EOC) Tests Transition Timeframe

Beginning in 2010-2011 and beyond, all incoming freshmen must pass three End-of-Course (EOC) Tests in the following categories to earn a standard diploma: (a) English II or English III; (b) Algebra I or Geometry; and (c) Biology or American History.

GEE retests for all four subjects will be handled by the State through 2013-14; GEE retests for all four subjects will be handled by the districts in 2014-15.

For students with disabilities who have passed two of the three required EOC Tests and have exhausted all opportunities available through the end of the 12th grade to pass the remaining required EOC Test, that EOC Test may be waived by the State Superintendent of Education if the Department of Education determines the student's disability significantly impacts his/her ability to pass the EOC Test.
